"Alert Levy Emergency Notification System"

The Cedar Key Water and Sewer District will be using the Alert Levy Emergency Notification System to provide emergency notices to District customers. These notices can be very important. For example, if an emergency arises requiring all or some District customers to boil their water prior to drinking, that notice will go out on the Alert Levy system. Also, in case of tropical storm or hurricane, the District will likely send out important notices about service shut-offs and special actions that need to be taken by customers.

You may choose to receive these notices in one or more ways, including text message, email, and/or phone call. You will also receive important emergency notices from Levy County.
